

Head III – Papers A and B

There are no broad guidelines for this Head. Candidates will be tested on the Solicitors Regulation Authority's Test Specification for Head III (page 10) – available via the SRA's website:

The paper is split into two sections:

- Part 1 contains questions on Professional Conduct, Solicitors' Financial Services and Money Laundering – 60% of the marks
- Part 2 contains a ledger accounts question and 3-4 short answer questions – 40% of the marks

Candidates are reminded that they must score 50% of the available marks in each part of the paper to pass Head III - i.e. candidates must score at least 30 marks in Part 1 and at least 20 marks in Part 2 to pass the assessment. A fail in either part means that the candidate will have failed the assessment overall.
